

Lakewood and Ventura Gain Baseball Final

Lakewood, behind the shutout pitching of Tom Lederer, breezed past Covina, 5-0, and Ventura stopped Bishop Amat, 6-4, Thursday to earn berths in Monday's CIF AAAA baseball finals at Anaheim Stadium.

In the AAA semifinals, top-seeded Lompoc downed Bassett, 6-1, and El Segundo ripped Antelope Valley, 8-1. They will meet for the championship as part of Monday's Anaheim Stadium doubleheader.

Lederer (9-0) fired his second playoff three-hitter and collected two hits at the plate as Lakewood raised its season record to 21-2-1.

Ventura scored three runs in the last inning, the deciding two coming on a bases-loaded error, to eliminate Angelus League champion Bishop Amat.
